

2010 Meeting of SASS Governor

Below are agenda items voted on with results, also discussion items with notes.

1. Should we eliminate the 10-second minor safety penalty for **overloading a RIFLE?** 174 votes for 57%, 135 against 43%, 0% abstained. Item Failed did not receive 2/3 majority to pass.
2. Should we change the rule regarding **empties left on the carrier or in the chamber of a long gun?** 130 votes for 42%, 179 against, 0% abstained. Item failed.
3. Should we create the new sanctioned shooting category **Frontier Cartridge Gunfighter?** 194 votes for 63%, 115 against 37%, 0% abstained. Item failed did not receive 2/3 majority to pass.
4. The Burgess Rifle is a SASS legal Firearm. It was patented in 1882. **Should the rifle regulations for B-Western be changed as follows to allow the earliest rifle to be from 1880 instead of present 1884?** 278 votes for 90%, 30 against 10% 0% abstained

Discussion Items:

Mares Leg handgun as a main match firearm. **Not no, but Hell No! WB Agrees.**
